Borealis wants to take the lead in their industry's transition to a circular economy. It does so by increasing its production in mechanical recycling, as well as switching from fossil feedstock to sustainable feedstock, including feedstock from chemical recycling. This transition comes with developing new innovative technologies, accompanied by big changes and investments to our capital intensive asset base.

Now 8 years since we stepped into plastic recycling and started our circular journey, we have extended our recycling asset base, including 2 chemical recycling plants. We rolled out our circular portfolios in polyolefins and chemicals and remain our leading position in the market for offering circular polyolefin solutions.

However, many big steps are still to be taken in this transition. A transition that cannot be made incrementally, but might need a revolution to happen: what we call the Future Positive Plastic Revolution.
